



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2025-019

AN ORDER ACTIVATING CERTAIN DRRM FRAMEWORKS FOR THE FORTHCOMING NATIONAL YOUTH DAY CACERES 2025

WHEREAS, the National Youth Day (NYD) Caceres 2025 will be hosted by the Archdiocese of Caceres and component events held in Naga City on June 10 – 14, 2025;

WHEREAS, the five-day event will feature a pilgrimage of youth to seven pilgrim churches in Naga, a translation procession, plenary formations, workshops, immersions, enthronement of the patroness of Bicolandia, "Pagmamanto" which means the ceremonial act of placing the Virgin Mary's cloak over the pilgrims as a form of blessing for them, and the celebration of the Holy Masses;


WHEREAS, the said event is expected to draw thousands of youth pilgrims, volunteers, religious leaders, and visitors from across the country, requiring heightened levels of preparedness, coordination, and response from the City Government;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Republic Act No. 10121, also known as the "Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010," local government units are mandated to establish institutional mechanisms for disaster preparedness and emergency response, including the activation of Incident Command Systems, Emergency Operations Centers, and DRRM Response Clusters;

WHEREAS, the magnitude, scope, and complexity of NYD Caceres 2025 necessitate the activation of the Incident Management Team (IMT), the Emergency Operations Center (EOC), and the DRRM Response Clusters to ensure public safety, efficient resource mobilization, real-time coordination, and emergency readiness;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, NELSON S. LEGACION, City Mayor of Naga, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:








SECTION 1. ACTIVATION OF INCIDENT MANAGEMENT

TEAM (IMT). The City Incident Management Team (IMT) is hereby activated to oversee incident command, planning, operations, logistics, finance, and public information in connection with the National Youth Day Caceres 2025. The IMT shall be composed of the following:

The IMT shall:

- a. Prepare and implement a comprehensive Incident Action Plan (IAP) for NYD Caceres 2025;
- b. Conduct hazard and risk assessments, site inspections, and simulation drills;
- c. Establish emergency protocols, security measures, and crowd control plans;
- d. Provide medical response units, emergency communications, and contingency support;
- e. Coordinate with event organizers, barangays, and external support agencies;
- f. Submit daily reports to the EOC during event operations.





SECTION 2. ACTIVATION OF EMERGENCY OPERATIONS CENTER (EOC). The Emergency Operations Center (EOC) of Naga City is hereby activated to serve as the central coordination hub for communication, data monitoring, decision-making, and incident support operations throughout the NYD activities. The EOC shall operate on a 24/7 basis during the official event period and during the preparatory phase as determined necessary.

For the NYD Caceres 2025, the EOC shall be comprised by the following:



SECTION 4. INCIDENT ACTION PLANNING AND COORDINATION. The IMT is directed to immediately convene to formulate the Incident Action Plan (IAP) for NYD Caceres 2025 and coordinate with all response clusters and key partners, including the Archdiocese of Caceres, NYD National Secretariat, barangay units, national agencies, and private sector stakeholders.

SECTION 5. RESOURCE AND LOGISTICAL SUPPORT. All City Government departments and offices are directed to render full support to the IMT, EOC, and Response Clusters. Necessary funding and logistical resources shall be sourced from the City DRRM Fund and other available city appropriations, subject to usual accounting and auditing rules.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in full force until the completion and demobilization of all response operations and post-event assessments related to the National Youth Day Caceres 2025.
