RECONSTITUTING THE NAGA CITY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9003, otherwise known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000, provides a framework for the creation and operation of a Solid Waste Management Board that is primarily tasked to prepare submit and implement a plan for the safe and sanitary management of solid waste generated in a local government's geographic and political coverage;

WHEREAS, since 2001, the City Government of Naga, through Ordinance No. 2001-073, has constituted the said board and has provided for an integrated structure which will advance an interdisciplinary perspective in handling the city's solid waste;

NOW THEREFORE, I, MARIA LEONOR G. ROBREDRO, Mayor of Naga City, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

SECTION 1. NAGA CITY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD. The Naga City Solid Waste Management Board is hereby reconstituted with the following composition:

The aforesaid individuals who are non-government employees are entitled to necessary travelling expenses and allowances chargeable against the funds of the Solid Waste Management Board, subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

SECTION 3. FUNCTIONS. The Naga City Solid Waste Management Board shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

- A. Develop the City Solid Waste Management Plan that shall ensure the long-term management of solid waste, as well as integrate the various solid waste management plans, and strategies of the barangays in its area of jurisdiction, provided that, in the development thereof, consultations with the various sectors of the community shall be continued;
- B. Adopt measures to promote and ensure the viability and effective implementation of solid waste management programs in the city's component barangays;
- C. Monitor implementation of the City Solid Waste Management Plan through the barangays and in cooperation with the private sector and the NGOs;
- D. Adopt specific revenue-generating measures to promote the viability of its Solid Waste Management Plan;
- E. Convene regular meetings for purposes of planning and coordinating the implementation of the solid waste management plans of the respective component barangays;
- F. Review every two (2) years, or as the need arises, the City Solid Waste Management Plan for purposes of ensuring its sustainability, viability, effectiveness, and relevance in relation to local and international developments in the field of solid waste management;
- G. Develop the specific mechanics and guidelines for the implementation of the City Solid Waste Management Plan;
- H. Recommend specific measures or proposals for franchise or build-operate-transfer agreements with duly recognized institutions, pursuant to RA 6957 and other appropriate government rules and regulations on contracts, franchises and build-operate-transfer agreements, to provide either exclusive or non-exclusive authority for the collection, transfer, storage, processing, recycling, or disposal of municipal solid waste;

- I. Recommend measures and safeguards against pollution and for the preservation of the natural ecosystem;
- J. Coordinate the efforts of members of Metro Naga in the implementation of the Solid Waste Management Plan for the area; and
- K. Promote and encourage, in coordination with concerned non-government organizations, the creation of multi-purpose environment cooperatives in the 27 barangays of Naga, especially as to marketing and recycling of organic fertilizer and non-degradable wastes.

SECTION 4. SECRETARIAT. The Solid Waste Management Office shall serve as Secretariat to the Solid Waste Management Board.

SECTION 5. AMENDMENTS AND INTERPRETATION. This Order may be amended or supplemented as may be deemed necessary, and shall be interpreted to give full force and effect to the attainment of the declared policy and the operationalization of the principles of good governance.

SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE. All issuances and orders inconsistent with this Order are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.

SECTION 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this Order is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY. This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect unless otherwise revoked or amended, or until superseded by an ordinance.
