**CREATING AN AD HOC ASSESSMENT COMMITTEE TO ADDRESS THE
FLOODING ALONG NINOY AND CORY AVENUE**

WHEREAS, the City of Naga has experienced persistent rains resulting in recurrent flooding in major areas of the city;

WHEREAS, one of the areas severely affected is Ninoy and Cory Avenue in Barangay Triangulo, where flooding has caused significant disruption to daily activities, livelihoods, and the movement of people and goods;

WHEREAS, it is imperative for the City Government to immediately investigate the causes of flooding in the area and identify appropriate, short- and long-term solutions;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARIA LEONOR G. ROBREDO, Mayor of the City of Naga by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order creation of the Ad Hoc Assessment Committee to Address the Flooding Along Ninoy and City Avenue, to wit:

SECTION 1. AD HOC ASSESSMENT COMMITTEE. The Ad Hoc Assessment Committee to Address the Flooding Along Ninoy and City Avenue (Ad Hoc Assessment Committee) is hereby reconstituted, with the following composition:

SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS, DUTIES, AND RESPONSIBILITIES. The Ad Hoc Assessment Committee shall conduct a comprehensive assessment of the recent flooding incidents along Ninoy and Cory Aquino Avenue, City of Naga. The assessment shall include, but not be limited to, the following:

- a. Examination of the condition and capacity of the existing drainage system, including identification of any obstructions, blockages, or structural damage;
- b. Evaluation of the drainage outflow and its sufficiency to accommodate peak water volumes;
- c. Review of contributing factors such as solid waste accumulation, siltation, and encroachments; and
- d. Integration of findings into the City's overall assessment of drainage and flood management problems.

SECTION 3. SUBMISSION OF REPORT. The Committee shall submit its report and recommendations to the Office of the City Mayor within thirty (30) calendar after the issuance of this Order. .

SECTION 4. AMENDMENTS AND INTERPRETATION. This Order may be amended or supplemented as may be deemed necessary, and shall be interpreted to give full force and effect to the attainment of the declared policy and the operationalization of the principles of good governance.



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SECTION 5. REPEALING CLAUSE. All issuances and orders inconsistent with this Order are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.

SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this Order is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY. This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect unless otherwise revoked or amended, or until superseded by an ordinance.
