WHEREAS, the City Disaster Risk Reduction Management Fund (CDRRMF) for Fiscal Year 2025 amounts to Ninety-Three Million Nine Hundred Sixty-Two Thousand and One Hundred Twenty-Seven Pesos (Php 93,962,127.00), which shall be allocated to various DRRM programs, projects, and activities to enhance the city's capacity for disaster resilience;
