**RESOLUTION NO. 2024-008**

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**A RESOLUTION ALLOCATING THE NAGA CITY DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT FUND AMOUNTING TO NINETY-THREE MILLION NINE HUNDRED SIXTY-TWO THOUSAND AND ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-SEVEN PESOS (PHP 93,962,127.00) TO VARIOUS DISASTER RISK REDUCTION MANAGEMENT PROGRAMS, PROJECTS, AND ACTIVITIES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025 AND ENDORSING THE SAME TO THE CITY DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL AND THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD FOR ADOPTION AND INCLUSION IN THE ANNUAL INVESTMENT PLAN FOR 2025:**

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**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 10121, otherwise known as the "Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010," mandates local government units to allocate resources for disaster risk reduction management (DRRM) to ensure a proactive and comprehensive approach to disaster preparedness, response, mitigation, and rehabilitation;

**WHEREAS**, the City Disaster Risk Reduction Management Fund (CDRRMF) for Fiscal Year 2025 amounts to Ninety-Three Million Nine Hundred Sixty-Two Thousand and One Hundred Twenty-Seven Pesos (Php 93,962,127.00), which shall be allocated to various DRRM programs, projects, and activities to enhance the city's capacity for disaster resilience;

**WHEREAS**, the allocation of the CDRRMF is broken down as follows:

- a. Quick Response Fund (30%):           Php 28,188,638.00
- b. Disaster Prevention and Mitigation:    Php 39,573,800.00
- c. Disaster Preparedness:                 Php 16,912,000.00
- d. Disaster Response:                     Php 1,600,000.00
- e. Disaster Rehabilitation and Recovery:   PhP 7,687,689.00

**WHEREAS**, the proposed allocation ensures the comprehensive and strategic implementation of DRRM programs, projects, and activities aimed at safeguarding lives, properties, and livelihoods against disasters;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, on motion duly seconded, the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council hereby resolves:

1. To allocate the Naga City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund amounting to Ninety-Three Million Nine Hundred Sixty-Two Thousand and One Hundred Twenty-Seven Pesos (Php 93,962,127.00) to various DRRM programs, projects, and activities for Fiscal Year 2025 as detailed below:

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


**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that copies of this resolution be furnished to the City Development Council and the Sangguniang Panlungsod for their appropriate action.
