RESOLUTION URGENTLY AND STRONGLY REQUESTING THE BOARD OF THE NATIONAL HISTORICAL COMMISSION OF THE PHILIPPINES TO ALLOW LOCAL CONSULTATIONS ON THE SPANISH-ERA RUINS IN NAGA CITY TO PROCEED AND BE CONSUMMATED:-

On joint and collective motion

WHEREAS, in its July 14, 2025 email to the City Planning and Development Office (CPDO), the National Historical Commission of the Philippines is said to be amenable to lifting the Cease-and-Desist (CDO) on Nagaland Corporation, owner of two Spanish-era ruin structures located in Naga City, after having already complied with the Commission's basic requirement;

WHEREAS, during its July 28, 2025 committee meeting, the Committee on Culture and the Arts of the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Naga City treated the matter and invited Nagaland Corporation to attend, with the end view of explaining its proposed development anchored on the Conservation Management Plan and Architectural Plan submitted to the Commission;

WHEREAS, Nagaland did not attend said committee meeting, preventing the Committee to achieve the objective set forth in the CPDO's June 19, 2025 letter to defer action on the Nagaland's proposed development, which the Board granted, aimed at allowing "the developer... to present details of the proposed project, for appreciation and comments by the local stakeholders";

WHEREAS, the recent habagat weather events last week further complicated matters, forcing national and local government agencies in the Bicol Region to cancel classes and government work, thereby preventing more timely government action at the local level;

WHEREAS, the city government, as a matter of policy, puts premium on collaborative governance and people participation in decision-making on issues of vital importance, which includes the Spanish-era structures which are the subject matter of this issue at hand;

NOW, THEREFORE, on joint and collective motion of the 15th Sangguniang Panlungsod of Naga and the 2025 City Youth Sangguniang Panlungsod;

BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to urgently and strongly request the Board of the National Historical Commission of the Philippines to allow local consultations on the Spanish-era ruin structures in Naga City to proceed and be consummated before lifting the Cease-and-Desist Order (CDO) it previously issued on proposed development in the area.

LET COPIES of this resolution be furnished to the National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP) and the Nagaland Corporation for their information and appropriate action.
