ORDINANCE NO. 2020 - 074

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AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE NAGA CITY BUSINESS STIMULUS PROGRAM AND SETTING ASIDE FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE; -

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Naga that:

SECTION 1. Short Title. This Ordinance shall be known as the Naga City Business Stimulus Ordinance.

SECTION 2. Creation and Purpose. The Naga City Business Stimulus Program (NCBSP) is hereby created to help qualified small businesses survive the economic slowdown caused by the Covid 19 Pandemic and make them active partners in reviving our local economy. The NCBSP shall be a temporary measure distinct and separate from the regular livelihood programs of the city government.

SECTION 3. Definition of Terms. For the purpose of this Ordinance, the following terms shall mean, as follows:

- a. Small Business Enterprises engaged in wholesale and retail trade, food and tourism services, fabrication and production activities that are registered in the City of Naga with an asset not exceeding Three Million (P3M) Pesos.
- b. Workers or employees those who run, operate or work in the business. For the purpose of determining the loan ceiling set in this Ordinance, the spouse and dependent children of the owner of the business shall not be pounted.
- c. Days refers to working days as used in this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. Nature of Assistance. The NCSBP shall consist of the following:

a. Lero-Interest credit payable in one (1) year with payment to commence one (1) month after the lifting of nationally-imposed community quarantine, or six (6) months from release of loan, whichever comes first. The maximum loanable amount shall depend on the number of workers employed by the enterprise, as follows: (i) up to P10,000 if employing at least one (1) worker; (ii) up to P10,000 if employing at least two (2) workers; iii up to P75,000 if employing at least three (3) workers; iv/ up to P100,000 if employing more than three 3 workers.

a. Technical and marketing assistance as needed by the enterprise to enable it to adapt to prevailing quarantime conditions or to the new normal. ORDINANCE NO. 2020-074 Series of 2020

SECTION 5. Eligibility Requirements. The Micro-Small Enterprise (MSE) to avail of loan must possess the following qualifications:

a. Operating in 2019 or prior to the Covid 19 pandemic.

- b. With at least one (1) worker prior to the pandemic who is/are residents of the City of Naga.
  - c. Has a valid Naga City Mayor's Permit.

SECTION 6. NCBSP Board. The NCBSP Board is hereby created to be composed of the following:

Chairperson: Chairperson, SP Committee on Trade, Investment, and Economic Business Enterprises

Members:

City Administrator Department Head, Metro PESO Department Head, Market Enterprise Promotion Office Negosyo Center Business Counselor Representative, Department of Trade and Industry President, Metro Naga Chamber of Commerce and Industry

Representative, Naga City People's Council

The Board shall meet at least twice (2 times) a month to review all applications and determine the amount of loan and any additional assistance that may be availed of from the city government, other government agencies, civil society, and the private sector.

The Metro PESO shall serve as Secretariat of the Board.

The representatives of DTI, MNCCI and NCPC shall be designated by their respective office or organization following their own procedures and submitting their names to the City Mayor for formal acceptance.

The NCBSP Board shall formulate guidelines, specific requirements and collection system not otherwise herein stavides, including penalties for delinquent loan payments.

SECTION 7. Implementation. Acceptance and initial scheering shall be done by Metro PESO following its forms and concernes. The screening process shall be for the purpose of ensuring that the documents necessary to establish eligibility are complete and that the information contained therein are 1240.

The screened applications shall be endorsed to the Board for evaluation, after which it shall forward its recommendation to the City Mayor for final action.

**SECTION 8.** Powers and Functions of the NCBSP Board. The Board shall have the following powers and functions:

- a. Assess each application as to its compliance with the eligibility requirement, its need for assistance, its impact in preserving or creating employment, and its viability given the restrictions under prevailing quarantine condition.
- b. Prioritize the applicants in the event of limitation in funding.
- c. Upon request of the Applicant, or upon initiative of the Board, arrange for other assistance needed by the Applicant that may be available from other government agencies, or those from civil society organizations and the private sector.
- d. Submit a monthly report to the City Mayor and the Sangguniang Panlungsod as to the statues of the NCBSP and its beneficiaries and any recommendation to further improve the NCBSP.

SECTION 9. Processing Period. Upon receipt of a complete application, Metro PESO shall have one (1) week to verify the material facts contained therein. Verified applications shall be firmished the members of the Board thru a Group Chat created for the Purpose.

For loan applications amounting to P25,000.00 or below, approval by majority of the Board given thru the Group Chat shall suffice and the same shall be forwarded the City Mayor for final action. However, a request by any member of the Board to have the same deliberated upon in a regular meeting shall result in the application being included in the agenda of the nearest scoredules Board meeting.

For loan applications over P25,000.00, the documents shall likewise be posted on the Group Chat and shall be passed upon by the Board on the nearest scheduled Board meeting.

Applications favorably acted upon by the Board shall be active to the City Mayor on the next working day for final The City Mayor shall approve or disapprove the same active test 2 days from receipt thereof.

Verta BESO shall prepare the corresponding voucher within the from receipt of approved application and endeavor that the same processed and released within four (4) days.

SECTION 10. Monitoring and Evaluation. Metro PESO shall periodically monitor the recipient enterprise and undertake such measures necessary to help the business survive the pandemic. Interventions which are beyond its resources and mandate shall be brought to the attention of the Board for appropriate action. A quarterly monitoring and evaluation report of all beneficiaries, along with any recommendation, shall be submitted to the Board for its appropriate action.

**SECTION 11.** Funding. An initial amount of Ten Million (P10M) Pesos shall be set aside for NCBSP to be sourced from savings generated from the suspension of obligations on certain accounts due to quarantine regulations, such as training and travelling expenses. A supplemental budget shall be passed for this purpose. Any additional appropriation shall be conditioned on a favorable assessment of the program.

SECTION 12. Sunset Provision. The NCBSP shall dease to be effective one (1) year from the lifting of the community guarantine unless the need for it remains as determined by the Sangduniang Panlungsod.

SECTION 13. Repealing Clause. Any provision of other ordinates, executive orders, and rules and regulations inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 14. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect
