

Senior citizens, persons with disabilities, and students shall be provided with discount of Twenty percent (20%) or a passenger rate of Twelve pesos (Php12), provided, they shall show to the driver a valid identification card.



**SECTION 3. – Installation of Protective Barriers.** – Trimobiles, Etrikes and taxicles shall install protective barriers between the driver and passenger to ensure health protection, based on the Memo Circular released by the IATF, enforcement of which shall be done by the PSO, PNP and duly accredited force multipliers.

**SECTION 4. – Guidelines for Operators and Drivers.** – A public utility vehicle operator or driver must:

- (a) Wear protective gear such as jacket or long-sleeved shirt, closed shoes, long pants and other necessary protective gear when driving or operating the vehicle;
- (b) Wear a face mask and use own full face shield completely covering the nose and the mouth at all times;
- (c) Sanitize and disinfect the face shield, hands, seats and barriers before and in between rides;
- (d) Observe and abide all applicable traffic rules and regulations;
- (e) An operator or driver may refuse the following passengers:
  - (1) Those under the influence of alcohol, drugs and other banned substances;
  - (2) Person with Disability (PWD) who cannot hold on safely;
  - (3) Children covered covered by R.A. 10666 or the Children's Safety on Motorcycle Act of 2015;
  - (4) Pregnant women; and/or
  - (5) Those who are non-compliant to the required health protocols in Section 5 below;
  - (6) Only accept one (1) tricycle back-rider at a time.

**SECTION 5. – Guidelines for Passengers.** – A passenger must:

- (a) Wear protective gear such as jacket or long-sleeved shirt, closed shoes, long pants and other necessary protective gear when driving or operating the vehicle;
- (b) Wear a face mask and use own full face shield completely covering the nose and the mouth at all times;
- (c) Ensure that the hands are sanitized before boarding and after disembarking the vehicle.

**SECTION 6. – Areas of Operation.** – Trimobiles, Etrikes and Taxicles shall operate only within their prescribed areas of operation pursuant to their respective franchises, and to existing ordinances and/or other issuances of the Sangguniang Panlungsod. No cross-border transport is allowed.

**SECTION 7. – Penalties.** – Any individual, passenger, driver or operator who refuses or fails to comply with the provisions of this ordinance shall suffer the following

finest and penalties, notwithstanding with the filing of complaints for violations of other law/s or ordinances:

- (a) First offense -a fine of Two Thousand Pesos (Php2,000.00);
- (b) Second offense -a fine of Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php3,500.00)
- (c) Third offense and subsequent offenses – a fine of Five Thousand Pesos (Php5,000.00) for each instance of violation.

**SECTION 8. – Separability Clause.** – Any provision or portion of this ordinance found to be in violation of the Constitution or invalid shall not impair the other provisions or parts thereof and shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 9. – Repealing Clause.** – All existing ordinances, rules and regulations or parts thereof, which are inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, modified and/or supplemented accordingly.

**SECTION 10. – Effectivity.** – This ordinance shall take effect after publication in a newspaper of general circulation in Naga City and compliance with posting requirements laid down by law.




