



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 052

**CREATING A TASKFORCE FOR CLEAN UP AND CLEARING OF WATERWAYS
AND EASEMENTS IN NAGA CITY**

WHEREAS, the City of Naga, due to its geographical location, remains highly vulnerable to natural disasters such as typhoons, earthquakes, and floods, which pose serious threats to life, property, and critical infrastructure;

WHEREAS, Naga City, being vulnerable to flooding and other climate-related hazards, underscores the vital importance of keeping its waterways clean and unobstructed as a preventive and mitigating measure against calamities such as typhoons, heavy rains, and flash floods;

WHEREAS, the presence of garbage, silt, and other obstructions in rivers, esteros, canals, easements and drainage systems greatly exacerbates flooding, causes damage to property, endangers public health, and disrupts livelihoods during disasters;

WHEREAS, the City Government finds it imperative to create a Task Force that will lead, coordinate, and sustain a comprehensive clean-up and maintenance program for the city's waterways;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARIA LEONOR G. ROBREDO, Mayor of the City of Naga by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order creation of a taskforce for clean up of waterways in Naga City, to wit:

SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS, DUTIES, AND RESPONSIBILITIES. The Taskforce shall:

1. Develop and implement a clean-up program for the city's waterways;
2. Clear obstructions along rivers, canals, easements and drainage systems;
3. Coordinate with barangays for clean-up drives and dredging operations;
4. Monitor and evaluate the condition of rivers, canals, and drainage systems;
5. Recommend policies and measures to prevent garbage dumping and obstruction of waterways;
6. Submit a report to the Office of the City Mayor.

SECTION 3. AMENDMENTS AND INTERPRETATION. This Order may be amended or supplemented as may be deemed necessary, and shall be interpreted to give full force and effect to the attainment of the declared policy and the operationalization of the principles of good governance.

SECTION 4. REPEALING CLAUSE. All issuances and orders inconsistent with this Order are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.



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SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this Order is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY. This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect unless otherwise revoked or amended, or until superseded by an ordinance.
