**RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT -
SAGIP SAKA FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF THE HEREUNDER GOODS
AND SERVICES**

WHEREAS, RA No. 11321, otherwise known as the "Sagip Saka Act," and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), provides that "[t]o promote and support farmers and fisherfolk enterprise development, national and local government agencies shall directly purchase locally produced agricultural and fishery products from accredited farmers and fisherfolk cooperatives and enterprises; provided that said agricultural and fishery products are necessary in the performance of their respective mandates;

WHEREAS, Section 11.2 of the IRR of RA No. 11321 further provides that "the procurement by national and local government agencies of said agricultural and fishery products, including agricultural and fishery inputs directly produced by local farmers and fisherfolk, shall be exempted from the application of the bidding process prescribed under relevant government procurement laws: Provided that said agencies shall undergo a negotiated procurement under the applicable guidelines of the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB)";

WHEREAS, Section 75 of RA No. 12009 and its IRR provide that the PEs shall encourage active participation of registered sectors in all procurement activities by giving weight to gender parity, ethnic equity, and other social factors, and by integrating marginalized groups and socially responsible enterprises into government procurement;

WHEREAS, Parallel to Sagip Saka Act, GPPB Resolution 08-2025 was issued to provide for the guidelines in implementing Negotiated Procurement - Sagip Saka for the procurement of agricultural and fishery products necessary for the performance of the respective mandates of government agencies;

WHEREAS, Under Negotiated Procurement - Sagip Saka, the Procuring Entity may contract directly to Farmers or Fisherfolk whether through cooperatives,

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enterprises, group or individual subject to the minimum eligibility requirement provided in GPPB Resolution 08-2025;

WHEREFORE, the BAC hereby recommends to the HOPE, that the goods and services indicated hereto be procured under Negotiated Procurement - Sagip Saka.


