



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 010

**AN ORDER ENJOINING ALL BARANGAY GOVERNMENTS OF NAGA CITY
TO FULLY IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 97-092,
AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 2001-005, SPECIFICALLY MANDATING
THE FORMATION OF BARANGAY DOG POUND CATCHING TEAMS AND
THE ENFORCEMENT OF ANIMAL CONTROL REGULATIONS**

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. 97-092, otherwise known as "An Ordinance Regulating the Ownership, Care and Upkeep of Animals in the City of Naga," was enacted to ensure public health and safety through the responsible management of animals;

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. 2001-005 amended Section 13 of the original ordinance, introducing Section 13-B (Barangay Initiative), which explicitly mandates each Barangay Council to form its own Dog Pound Catching Team;

WHEREAS, the same amendment entrusts these Barangay Teams with the implementation of all provisions of the animal regulation ordinance within their respective jurisdictions, making the composition and operation of such teams a primary responsibility of the Barangay Council;

WHEREAS, Section 13-C of said ordinance provides a fiscal incentive for this local initiative, allowing a fifty-fifty (50/50) sharing of proceeds from fines and penalties between the City and the concerned Barangay, to be used exclusively for the operations of the Dog Pound Catching Team;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARIA LEONOR G. ROBREDO, Mayor of Naga City, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:



SECTION 1. MANDATORY FORMATION OF BARANGAY DOG POUND CATCHING TEAMS. All twenty-seven (27) barangays of the City of Naga are hereby [mandated or enjoined] to organize and formalize their respective Barangay Dog Pound Catching Teams. The composition of these teams shall be determined by the Barangay Council through a supporting Barangay Ordinance or Resolution.

SECTION 2. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES. The Barangay Dog Pound Catching Teams shall be responsible for:

- The apprehension and impoundment of stray animals within their territorial jurisdiction.
- Assisting in the enforcement of registration and vaccination requirements for canine and feline pets.
- Monitoring compliance with the penalties outlined in Section 13 and 13-A, including the ₱1,000.00 fine for impounded animals.

SECTION 3. FUNDING AND REVENUE SHARING. In accordance with Section 13-C, the Barangay Treasurer is directed to coordinate with the City Treasurer to draw the barangay's 50% share of collected fines. These funds must be utilized solely for the personnel, equipment, and operational expenses of the catching team.

SECTION 4. SUPERVISION. The City Veterinary Office and the Naga City Animal Pound shall provide technical assistance, training, and coordination to all Barangay Dog Pound Catching Teams to ensure humane and effective animal handling.

SECTION 5. AMENDMENTS AND INTERPRETATION. This Order may be amended or supplemented as may be deemed necessary, and shall be interpreted to give full force and effect to the attainment of the declared policy and the operationalization of the principles of good governance.

SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE. All issuances and orders inconsistent with this Order are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.

SECTION 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this Order is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY. This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect unless otherwise revoked or amended, or until superseded by an ordinance.
